

Local company beautifies Super Bowl arena

As Super Bowl Sunday approaches, a Fort Bend County business is busy spreading green around the Reliant Stadium.

Houston Landscapes Unlimited has been selected to beautify the area around the field before the big game. Harris County Sports & Convention Corporation has hired Houston Landscapes Unlimited to make the area surrounding Reliant Stadium look super.

Houston Landscapes Unlimited crews have overseeded the turf surrounding the stadium with rye grass to quickly return the lawn to a dark green color.
